CaringWorks was founded in 2002 and was built on the single idea that all people, no matter their social or economic standing, should have a chance to improve their quality of life. Since our founding, we've focused on a suite of services aimed at providing permanent, proven solutions for people facing homelessness. We focus our efforts on individuals with significant obstacles to housing stability.

SERVICES

Through quality supportive housing, behavioral health, and a myriad of support services, CaringWorks is breaking the cycle of homelessness, one person, one family, at a time.

► **Supportive housing for short-term and long-term needs**

Using a housing-first approach, our clients have a safe place to live while they receive the support services they need.

► **Behavioral health**

We provide and coordinate a wide range of clinical, community-based behavioral health services.

► **Outpatient treatment**

Individuals gain the insight and skills to navigate life's challenges and transitions while receiving recovery support.

► **Residential addiction treatment**

We operate Hope House in downtown Atlanta, a 70-bed facility which provides comprehensive services for men experiencing homelessness.

► **Services for deaf and hard-of-hearing men facing homelessness**

Through our Deaf Bridges to Recovery Program operated at Hope House, we provide residential treatment and recovery services for men who are deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind, deaf plus or late-deafened.

► **Additional essential supportive services**

Additional services delivered by CaringWorks professionals or one of our strategic partners are tailored to our clients' needs and may include employment assistance, legal assistance, health and wellness services, and more.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Each year thousands of people are homeless in metro Atlanta—more than 500 of them have a home with CaringWorks on any given day. CaringWorks has served approximately 10,000 clients throughout our 20-year history, growing exponentially to become one of Georgia's leaders in providing permanent supportive housing.

We serve hundreds of individuals each year through unique programs and services that are specifically tailored to the needs of those facing chronic homelessness. We provide affordable housing first and then we provide targeted solutions to help our clients overcome obstacles that are preventing them from remaining in a stable home.

While the yearly cost of chronic homelessness is nearly \$40,000 per person, CaringWorks can provide housing and services for less than \$13,000, resulting in substantial savings.

Our passion for the mission is a fundamental reason why CaringWorks clients succeed. As a testament to our motto that "caring does work," more than 90% of our clients continue to be stably housed one year after entering our programs.

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
