The program embraces the key principles of the Housing-First model, assisting residents to optimize their capacity for independent, healthy living.

### Who is Eligible?

- ***Women, aged 55 years or older.***
- ***Must have a verifiable, documented mental health disorder.***
- ***Must have documented proof of chronic homelessness as defined by HUD.***
- ***Must be able to sustain a household, independent of live-in aide or assistant.***
- ***Persons with psychiatric backgrounds must be free of imminent risk of harm to themselves or others.***



### What does CaringWorks Offer?

CaringWorks offers permanent supportive housing and services that focus on whole health and wellness. The result – housing stability and a much more satisfying life for our residents. The program includes:

- ***Housing placement***
- ***Intensive Case Management***
- ***PEER Support Services (when needed)***
- ***Linkage to community resources***
- ***Connection to CaringWorks Behavioral Health Services (when needed)***
