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CaringWorks RISE VA Permanent Supportive Housing Program

CaringWorks RISE VA Permanent Supportive Housing program assists chronically homeless Veterans with housing, supportive services, and case management. Permanent Supportive Housing Programs (PSH) allow clients to obtain housing with case management services for an unlimited amount of time. Income is not required for program eligibility and the **RISE VA** PSH program embraces the key principles of the Housing-First model: to remove any barriers to housing and assist program participants in optimizing their capacity for independent living. **RISE VA** has helped Veterans move forward in their lives since 2012.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must be a U.S. military Veteran
- 2. Must be a single adult and a minimum of 18 years of age.
- 3. Client must be chronically homeless
- 4. Eligibility requires a verifiable disability
- 5. Potential clients must be referred through the DeKalb County Coordinated Entry System
